

Mailbox Mix-up solutions

The sample needs no paid materials. These lines belong only to Mailbox Mix-up.

sample-1 / 27

Hint 1: Each envelope shows one house number by the stamp.

Hint 2: Add the three numbers only.

Method: the stamps show 10, 8, and 9. $10 + 8 + 9 = 27$.

sample-2 / porch

Hint 1: The lookup table sits under the carrier note.

Hint 2: Use the total from the stamped envelopes.

Method: the lookup table maps 27 to porch. 15 would have been step, and 9 would have been gate. The solved selection is porch.

Check both steps before finishing

Check the addition and the chosen table row, not just the final word. Ask players to show 10, 8, and 9 on the envelopes, add them, and point to the row selected by their total. A guessed word alone is not completion. Read hints from your folded page-3 panel whenever needed, including before checking the total.

Closing line to read aloud

The bundle sits on the porch. The carrier can go. Thank you for sorting the mix-up.

Reset

Collect notes that show 27 or porch as the filled result. Replace marked player pages. Keep this sheet private.
